#### Films on Demand

New for Fall 2015, Films on Demand and Brightspace have released an embed plugin that will allow instructors to embed films directly into courses! This is now the only way to embed Films on Demand content into courses. To access the plugin, just click the "insert stuff" icon on any editing box, search for the title, and click insert. <u>Email the librarian</u> with any questions. Films on Demand is a multidisciplinary, streaming video resource that offers embeddable, ADA accessible educational and popular video titles from 870 producers, including TED, BBC, National Geographic, and PBS. Films on Demand videos can be accessed by students through either the Films on Demand link in the Online Library section of the External Links widget on every course Home Page. If a course has been designed with embedded Films on Demand videos, students will see direct links to them in the course content.
